During July the Badgers will be looking at "In The Garden". We will be looking at what grows in the garden, who lives in the garden and what we do in the garden.

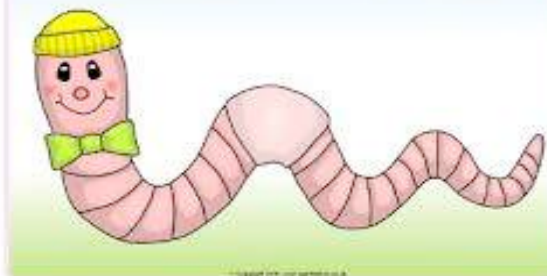


Song This Month:
