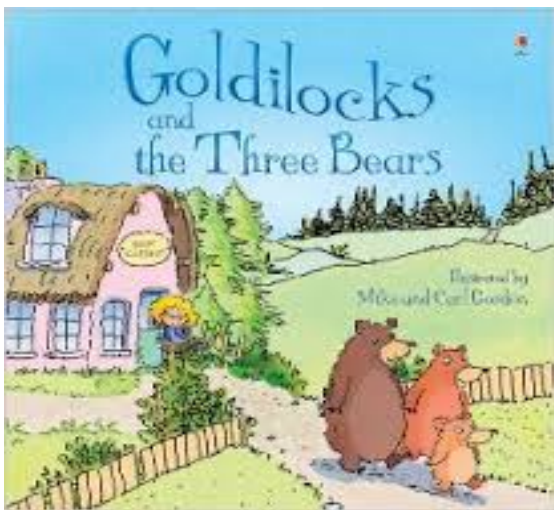


## Brambles March Newsletter 2019

### Staff News

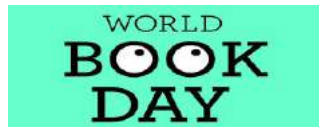
