Out came the sun and dried up all the rain,

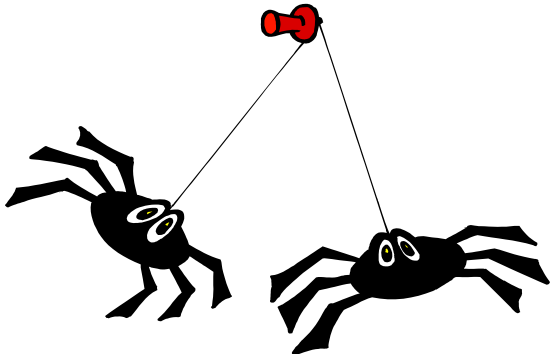
